

## Planting List C – Restricted Species List

Alien flower and grass species restricted from Larch Park. Some of these plants, such as Maltese Cross, are horticultural favourites. However, they can 'get away' from areas where they are planted and enter wild areas (e.g., Edmonton's parks). Also on this list are common lawn grasses, such as Creeping Red Fescue and Kentucky Blue Grass. If lawn grasses are used, they should be used as little as possible, and be surrounded by native species.
